Equipment and Tools Needed:

- Drill
- T20 security bit
- Phillips head bit
- Self-taping screws (size to be determined by installer)

Safety Precautions:

Whenever working on an EVSE or other electrical equipment <u>safety is the number one priority</u>, make sure that the <u>charger is de-energized and safe to begin work on</u>.

Required Safety Equipment:

- Safety Glasses
- Safety Gloves

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Pre-Commissioning

1.1 Bracket Removal

After removing the ICE 80A from the box, start the bracket removal process by:

Removing the single screw from the bottom of the unit.



- Once the first screw has been removed, you will beable to remove the cover of the front cover of the unit.
- After the cover has been removed, remove the five T20 security screws on the front face of the unit.





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 Next, locate the screw that's in the bottom half of the charger in the top right corner.



 Once this screw has been removed, the bracket will slide right off the back end.




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1.2 Bracket Mounting

After removing the bracket from the back of the ICE 80A unit:

- Hold the bracket up to the desired side of the pedestal and mark the two center holes in the desired placement of the bracket.
- Note 1: Make sure to leave enough room at the top for the black pedestal hole cover to beable to slide into place.
- Note 2: Make sure the brackets orientation is the same as what is pictured below.



 Next, take two self-tapping screws and insert them into the marked holes to mount the bracket on the pedestal.





1.3 Charger Reassembling

Once the bracket has been properly mounted to the pedestal:

Slide the ICE 80A onto the bracket.




• After placing the charger back onto the bracket, place the screw back into place and assure that the charger is secure to the pedestal.



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 Next, reinstall the five T20 security screws into the front face of the charger.



 Snap the outer cover back onto the charger and reinstall the remaining screw on the bottom lip of the charger to hold the face plate in place.
